Its goal is to empower undocumented students and address their needs through resources and services that enhance and support their academic, career and personal journey.

The program offers guidance, resources, financial aid and scholarship application assistance, immigration legal services, mental health services, informational sessions related to immigration policies, and workshops that center the undocumented experience.
