ASSOCIATE OF ART

This option requires the Certificate of Achievement - Child Development/ Preschool Director (which includes 3 classes on administration and supervision) + a 6-unit Specialty Option and the required general education courses at Cerritos College. Course work for this degree will fulfill Department of Social Services licensing requirements to be a director/administrator of an Early Childhood Program. This degree also meets the educational requirements for the Child Development Permit at the Site Supervisor level granted by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
